This convenient bench top bin allows you to recycle food scraps and organic material with ease. Best of all, your Mini Muncher comes with a year's supply of compostable bags.

Organic material such as food scraps, uneaten food, pet waste, shredded paper, used tissues and paper towel can all be turned into nutrient rich compost when put in your green-lid food and organics bin.

More compostable bags

Most supermarkets provide compostable bags in the fruit and vegetable section. Additional rolls of compostable bags can also be collected from the City of Tea Tree Gully Civic Centre in Modbury.

Too big to go in your green-lid food and organics bin?

The City of Tea Tree Gully provides residents with free drop-off events for green organic waste on selected days throughout the year.

Hard waste and mattress collection

Households can book two collections per calendar year. You can book either a hard waste or a mattress collection at any time, subject to availability.

Book a collection at cttg.sa.gov.au/hardwaste or call Solo on 8159 5090.

- **Hard waste collection**

Residents can dispose of up to two cubic metres of hard waste or 2m x 1m x 1m.

- **Mattress collection**

Residents may dispose of up to two mattresses, or one mattress and one ensemble base.

Hazardous items don't belong in your bins

Hazardous items, such as batteries, mobile phones, electronics, garden chemicals, insect repellents, cleaners, automotive products and acids cannot go in your household bins. Instead, these items should be taken to drop-off points for specialised recycling and disposal.

Chemicals, paint and other items

Unwanted paint, household chemicals and selected items can be recycled through your local collection centre.

Batteries & mobile phones

Recycle batteries and mobile phones using one of the ecobatt collection containers at your local supermarket. For a list of locations, visit ecobatt.net

Printer cartridges

Recycle printer cartridges using one of the Cartridges 4 Planet Ark collection containers. For a list of locations, visit recyclingnearyou.com.au

Batteries, mobile phones and printer cartridges can also be recycled using the drop-off station at the City of Tea Tree Gully Civic Centre, Modbury.

Electronics with a cord or battery

Anything that plugs into a power point, uses a charger or is powered by a battery can be recycled through Unplug N' Drop collection facilities at your local Bunnings hardware store. For other locations, visit electronicrecyclingaustralia.com
